Bevo Agro, located in Langley BC, with 34 acres of greenhouses, is the largest supplier of propagated plants in North America. Bevo's main products are vegetable plants such as tomatoes, peppers, lettuce, and cucumbers, along with other plants such as bedding plants, flowers, trees, berries, and grasses.

To reduce heating costs and to mitigate the risks of fluctuating fuel costs, Bevo has installed large wood fuel burners, manufactured by Vyncke from Belgium.

Bevo engaged **BuildWorks Construction Inc.** to design, supply and construct this 19,200 square foot fuel storage facility, comprising concrete retaining walls and an 80 ft wide MegaDome engineered fabric structure. The arch-truss frames are fabricated from pre-galvanized steel with silicone bronze welding for long life performance. The white Powershield roof fabric is Fire-Retardant rated, and reduces solar heat gain.
